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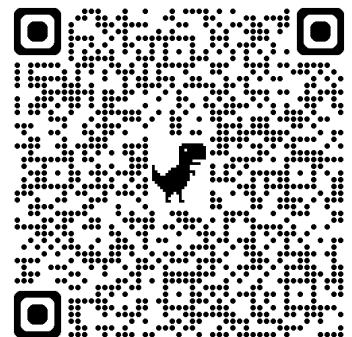

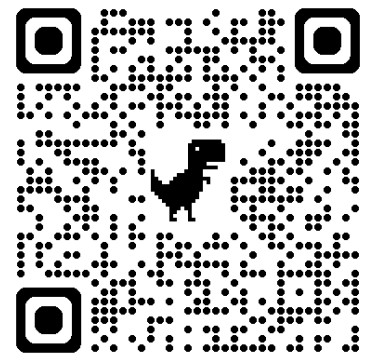

# Week 1 – Supply List

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## **Arrival & Guided Play**

# Arrival and Guided Play (5-10 minutes)

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Warmly greet children as they arrive and invite them to the play area. This week, we're learning about how Jesus helps us through the story of The Miraculous Catch of Fish (Luke 5:1-11). Use playful activities to introduce this idea and create a welcoming transition into class.

## **Toy/Activity Ideas:**

- **Toy Boats** – Let's pretend to float our boats on the water. What might we catch with our nets if we were fishing like Jesus' friends?
- **Plastic Fish or Fish Puzzle** – Can you find and match all the fish? Jesus' friends had a big surprise with so many fish!
- **Fishing Game (magnetic or pretend rods)** – Let's see how many fish we can catch! Do you think Jesus' friends were excited when their nets were full?
- **Blue Playdough** – Make waves and pretend to be on a big lake. Who might you meet on the water like Jesus' friends did?
- **Pretend Nets or Fabric Squares** – Let's spread out our nets and gather pretend fish. What would you do if you caught lots of fish like in today's story?

**Transition to Group Game:** Let's row our pretend boats over to the next activity. Can you paddle your arms like we're on the water?



# Group Games (5 minutes) Duck Duck Goose

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After all the children have arrived and are settled, invite the children to gather together to play this simple group game.

**SETUP:** Arrange the children in a circle on the floor or a rug.

**TEACHER:** We're going to play Duck Duck Goose, but instead of saying "duck" and "goose," let's use "fish" and "net" to remind us of today's story!

(Start the game by walking around the circle.) Tap each friend gently on the head and say "fish." When you say "net," the person you tap gets up and chases you around the circle.

If the "net" catches the "fish," they switch roles. If the "fish" makes it back to the open spot first, the "net" stays in the middle.

Let's cheer for our friends and have fun remembering how Jesus helped His friends catch so many fish!



# Bible Story (10 minutes)

## The Miraculous Catch of Fish

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**Bible Reference:** Luke 5:1-11

**Main Idea:** Jesus shows His power and calls us to follow Him.

**SUPPLIES NEEDED:**

- Picture of a fishing boat on a lake.
- Picture of a large net filled with fish.
- Picture of a happy fishermen holding fish.

**TEACHER:** (Sit with the children and show the picture of the fishing boat.)

Look at this boat! Long ago, some men named Peter and his friends used boats like this to catch fish. Can you pretend to paddle a boat with me? Paddle, paddle!

(Make rowing motions.)

Peter and his friends had been fishing all night, but guess how many fish they caught? (Hold up your hands and show zero.) None! No fish at all! They were so tired and ready to go home.

Then Jesus came. He said to Peter, "Go out into the deep water and let down your nets again." Do you think they would catch fish this time? Let's find out!

(Show the picture of the net filled with fish.)

Peter and his friends threw their net into the water. Can you throw your pretend nets? (Mime throwing a net.) And suddenly, so many fish swam into the net! Pull the net up with me—pull, pull! It was so heavy, their boat almost tipped over!





Peter was amazed. He knelt down and said to Jesus, "You are so powerful!" Jesus smiled and said, "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of people." That means Jesus wanted them to help others know about Him!

(Show the picture of the happy fishermen)

Peter and his friends left their boats and followed Jesus because they saw how wonderful He is. Jesus helps us too! Can you say that with me? "Jesus helps us!"

### **PRAYER TIME:**

Let's talk to God together. You can repeat after me.

Dear God,

Thank You for showing us Your power.

Thank You for helping us when we need You.

Help us to follow Jesus every day.

In Jesus' name, Amen.

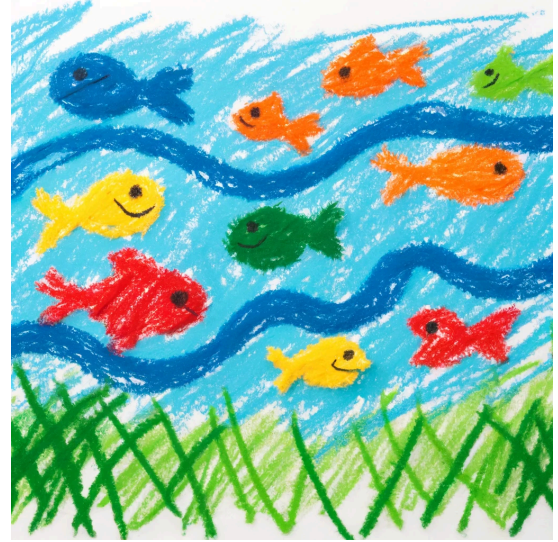
# Craft (10 minutes) Lake and Fish Picture

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## SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Blue construction paper or plain paper
- Crayons in various colors (blue, green, yellow, red, etc.)
- Optional: Stickers or stamps with fish shapes (if available)

## TEACHER:



Hand out a piece of paper and a few crayons to each child.

"Let's draw a big, beautiful lake, just like the one in our story! Use blue for the water and add waves or ripples if you like."

Once the children have drawn their lakes, say, "Now let's add some fish! Use your crayons to draw little fish swimming in the water. How many fish can you make?"

Encourage creativity by suggesting, "You can make big fish, small fish, or even colorful fish! Let's fill our lakes with lots of fish, just like Peter and his friends saw."
