When we truly understand His love, it fills our hearts and overflows to others.

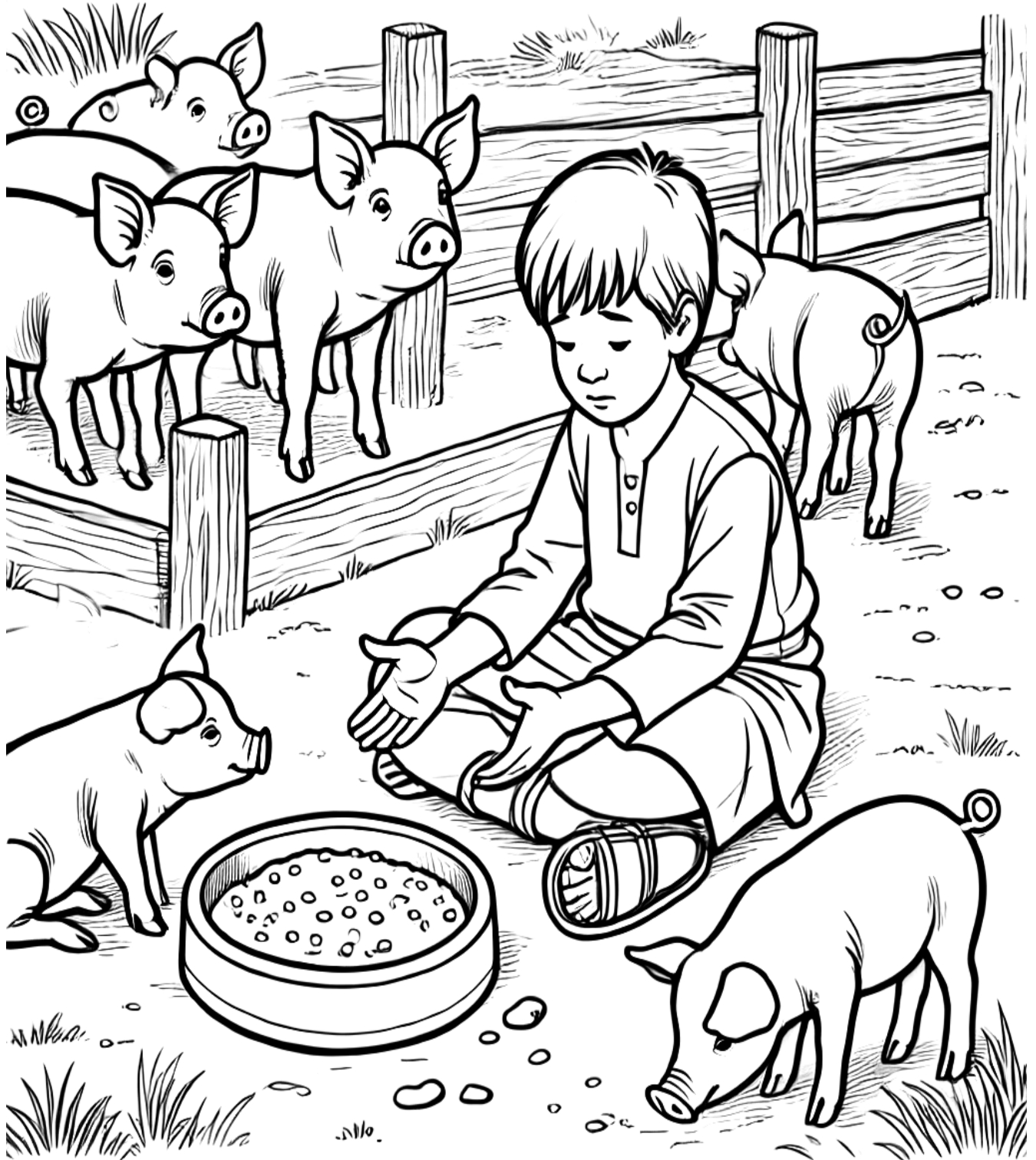
The Samaritan helped someone who was hurting—not because he had to, but because love was already in his heart. That's the kind of love God grows in us when we follow Jesus!

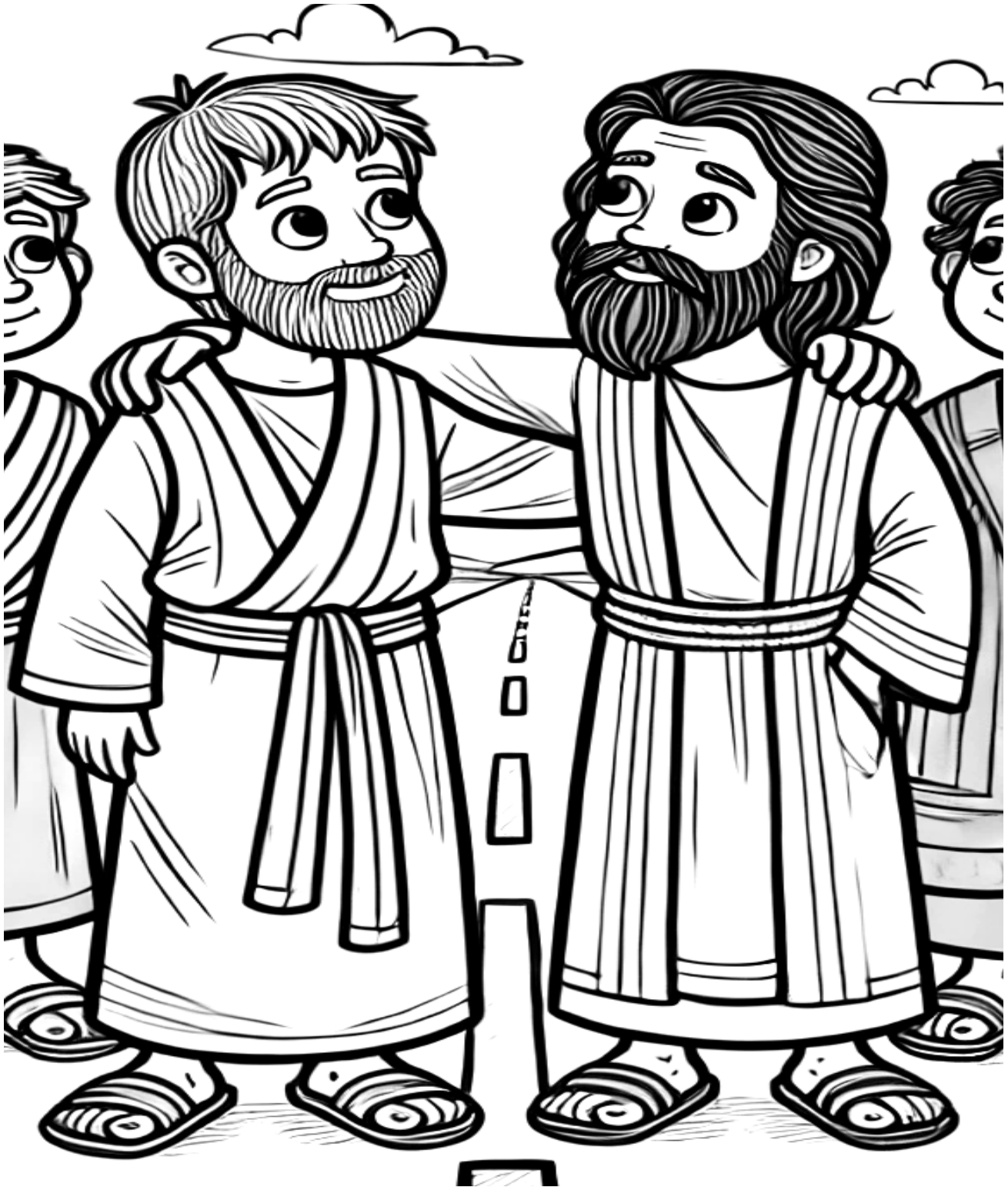
Jesus gives us a joy that doesn't fade, no matter what happens in life. His Spirit helps us find joy in God's love and share that joy with others.
