Sunday School Curriculum for Kids

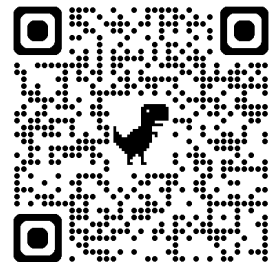


The "Foundations: Summer 2026 Quarter" curriculum follows God's story from the beginning to how He made a special agreement with His people. Kids will learn about who God is, how much He loves people, and how He always keeps His promises as they study key figures, the exodus from Egypt, and the first part of Israel's history.

These ready-to-use lessons are easy to prepare and keep students interested, no matter how many are in the class. The simple teacher guides don't require difficult preparation, guaranteeing strong lessons that work well for both large and small groups, making the Bible relevant when it matters most during the season.

**Key Themes:** From Creation to Covenant – God's Plan Unfolds

- God as Creator, Provider, and Promise-Keeper
- The importance of faith, obedience, and trusting God's timing
- God's faithfulness even when His people are unfaithful
- The foundation of God's covenant love and His plan for redemption



This quarter helps students learn who God is and how He works with people. Students will see that God has always had a plan and that He keeps His promises through real stories with real people. This prepares them to understand how God stayed faithful to His people throughout history and how He showed His greatest love by sending Jesus.

## 13-Week Curriculum Overview

**Big Idea:** From Creation to Covenant – God’s Plan Unfolds

**Chronological Bible Teaching:** Old Testament Law and Historical Books

Week	Date	Bible Lesson	Why is it Foundational?
1	June 7	The Story of Creation - Genesis 1	God made the whole world good and made people in His image. Jesus is the Creator King who made us to know and love Him.
2	June 14	Hope in the Fall of Man - Genesis 3	Sin broke God’s perfect world, but God promised a Rescuer. Jesus is the One who defeats sin and Satan and brings us back to God.
3	June 21	Rainbow of Promise - Genesis 9	God judges sin but also shows mercy and keeps His promises. The rainbow reminds us that God saves, and Jesus is His greatest promise.
4	June 28	The Story of Joseph - Genesis 45	Even when people do wrong, God is still in control. He used Joseph to save many people, and He sent Jesus to save us from our sins.
5	July 5	Blessings from the Blazing Bush - Exodus 3	God is holy and knows His people’s pain. He called Moses to rescue Israel, and He sent Jesus to rescue us from slavery to sin.
6	July 12	The Ten Commandments - Exodus 20	God’s commands show what is right and good. His law shows we can’t be perfect on our own, so we need Jesus, who obeyed God perfectly for us.
7	July 19	Faith to Get Your Feet Wet - Joshua 3	God keeps His promises when His people trust and obey. Israel stepped into the river by faith; we can trust and follow Jesus the same way.
8	July 26	The Call of Samuel - 1 Samuel 3	God speaks and calls people, even children, to know and serve Him. Today He speaks through His Word and calls us to follow Jesus.
9	Aug 2	The Battle Belongs to the Lord - 1 Samuel 17	God is bigger than any giant we face. David’s victory points to Jesus, our true King, who defeats sin and death for us.
10	Aug 9	God Says Wait - 2 Samuel 7	God’s promises may take time, but He never forgets them. He promised David an everlasting King, and He kept that promise in Jesus.
11	Aug 16	Choose Wisely! - 1 Kings 3	Real wisdom comes from God, not from being smart on our own. Jesus is our wisdom and helps us make choices that honor God.
12	Aug 23	The Lord Speaks to Elijah - 1 Kings 19	God is close when we are tired, scared, or sad. He spoke gently to Elijah, and He comforts us today through Jesus and the Holy Spirit.
13	Aug 30	Naaman is Healed - 2 Kings 5	God can heal and save anyone who humbly trusts Him. Naaman’s washing points to how Jesus washes our hearts clean from sin.
